## **Protocols for Curling Club guided by the Public Health Dept**

It is MANDATORY that masks are worn in all areas of the clubhouse except for the ice surface, ON your sheet of ice.

Please use all doors that are marked EXIT and ENTER. Please practice the 6 foot rule as much as you can.

There will be a table set up for you to sanitize hands, show your identification, proof of vaccination and sign in for contact tracing. Your assigned ice sheets will be posted there as well.

You will also be signing a Club Waiver and a Declaration of Compliance form (Note this is only at the beginning of your season)

## Public Health rules as of now

When there is room available in the 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance of the clubhouse. (There is only seating for 10 people at a time, please comply with the six feet rule as much as you can)

You will take off your outside shoes ONLY please, bring your equipment etc with you and go to your assigned table, there you can change into the balance of your equipment.

Kitchen will be closed for now until further notice. The bar will be open if your division has a server with smart serve, there will also be chips for sale as well.

PLEASE wear your masks at all times while in the club house area, unless you are at your table sitting drinking/eating your refreshments.

You will be going on the ice when your sheet/table is called, SORRY no warmups or practicing at this moment.

Your will enter the ice through one door and exit through another.

You may take off your mask while your game is being played, if you choose to leave your mask on that is totally fine. Please only take off your mask when you get to your assigned sheet.

If you need to use the washroom while you are playing, you need to put on your mask at your sheet of ice and try to keep the 6 feet distance rule if you can and exit through the proper door.

While you are playing your game it is very IMPORTANT that you only touch your rocks. When clearing the house at each end PLEASE use your broom to move the rocks. There is no need to set the rocks in perfect order at this time, if you can somewhat set the pairs together that's great BUT use only your broom.

When pulling your rocks out for your turn to deliver please touch ONLY your rocks.

When your game is finished you will exit the ice through the exit door, your mask should already be on before you leave the ice. Please return to your assigned table, change, and relax if you choose but only at your assigned table.

## Score keeping

The Vice is the only person who touches the score board and who records the score in the clubhouse on the scoreboard sheet. Please try not to gather around the scoreboard or any other area.

When leaving the clubhouse please do in the same manner you entered. ONLY 10 people in the 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance at any given time.
